Step-by-Step Guide: Creating Your Personalized Brand Board

This guide will help you clearly define your visual brand identity using my Canva Brand Board template as an example. Your Brand Board will include your chosen fonts, colors, and inspirational imagery—all strategically selected to resonate deeply with your niche and target audience.

✅ Step 1: Access My Brand Board Template

Use the Canva template I provided as your starting point. Replace all the information—fonts, colors, and inspirational images—with selections that reflect your niche and personal brand.

- Replace my name and details with your own.
- Adjust headings and descriptions to match your niche.

✅ Step 2: Choose Your Brand Fonts

Look at the fonts I've selected (Cormorant Garamond, Playfair Display, Poppins) and review the psychology behind them on my example board. Now, identify your niche and find fonts that resonate specifically with your target audience and content style.

How to use AI for font psychology:

Ask an AI tool (like ChatGPT) the following prompt:

"I am creating content in the [your niche] niche aimed at [describe your ideal audience, e.g., women aged 25-35 interested in wellness and minimalism]. What type of font styles would psychologically appeal most strongly to my audience and why? Please suggest 3-4 specific fonts and explain their psychological impact."

✅ Step 3: Select Your Color Palette

Review the colors I selected (Café au Lait Brown, Soft Blush Pink, Slate Gray, Pure White) and their psychological impact provided in my example. Now, tailor your color choices to fit your own niche and audience psychology.

How to use AI for color psychology:

Ask an AI tool (like ChatGPT) the following prompt:

"I'm building my brand in the [your niche] niche targeting [describe your audience clearly, e.g., young professionals interested in eco-friendly lifestyle products]. What colors would psychologically attract this audience, and why? Please suggest 4-5 specific colors with their HEX codes and psychological reasons."

✅ Step 4: Inspirational Images (Mood Board)

Include images that reflect the style and emotion of your niche. Replace the photos I included with ones relevant to your content area.

Example themes:

- Skincare and beauty: elegant product shots, soft lighting, natural textures.
